Alberto Parrondo, 53-year-old from Madrid (Spain), with a master degree in Mathematics (Operations Research) from the Complutense University of Madrid, holds also a PDG (General Management Programme) from the IESE Business School and a Master of Public Administration from the University of Southern California. He was appointed in February 2017 as Vice President Strategy, Ground Transportation Systems for THALES. In April 2013 he was appointed as Vice President, Integrated Communications & Supervision (ICS) Systems BL in Ground Transportation Systems Global Business Unit for THALES. Parrondo is Honorary Professor at the Complutense University of Madrid, Mathematic Faculty, where he taught from 2004 Dynamic Programming, Mathematical Programming, Statistical Inference, Game Theory, Graph Theory, Combinatorial Optimization.
